

Community Housing Program



Lackon Pty Ltd is currently providing project management services to the Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council (NPARC) for the delivery of the Community Housing Program. This initiative involves the design and construction of 15 Class 1 residential dwellings across Umagico, Seisa, Injinoo, New Mapoon, and Bamaga as part of the Forward Remote Capital Program.

Originally funded with \$8.3 million, Lackon's support has helped NPARC secure additional funding, bringing the total to \$15 million to maximise the number of homes built within the available budget. The program is currently in Stage 1, preparation and planning leading into Stage 2, with construction set to begin in March 2024 and run through to June 2026.

Lackon is working closely with NPARC to manage resources, coordinate with state government departments, public utility authorities, and landowners, and ensure compliance with the Funding Agreement. Recently, the Council has also requested an additional \$3 million to further expand the program and meet the growing demand for housing in the region.









Social Housing Accelerator Program



Lackon is currently delivering the Social Housing Accelerator Program (20 x Extensions/Studios Program) of NPARC, a targeted initiative addressing overcrowding through bespoke housing solutions tailored to each household and site. This program is grounded in deep community consultation, with designs shaped by direct tenant engagement and guided by Occupational Therapist assessments to ensure that functional, accessible, and appropriate living spaces are provided.

Currently, the project is at Stage 1, where Lackon leads the development of tailored design responses including underbuilds, plug-ins, and self-contained studios.

A core element of Lackon's approach is facilitating early and ongoing engagement with tenants to ensure that the design outcomes are culturally appropriate, contextually relevant, and practically aligned with household dynamics. This ensures that each dwelling is not only compliant with the Design and Construction Standards for Remote Housing but also sustainable, affordable, adaptable, and accessible. key design drivers shared with Kowanyama Aboriginal Shire Council's current housing objectives.

Moruya Housing Infrastructure



Lackon is currently engaged by Eurobodalla Shire Council to support the design and delivery of the Moruya Housing Infrastructure Project, a major regional initiative that will enable the development of up to 1,000 Class 1 dwellings in Moruya, NSW. Funded through the NSW Government's Accelerated Infrastructure Fund in combination with Council resources, the project focuses on delivering critical enabling infrastructure, such as trunk stormwater networks, intersection upgrades, traffic calming measures, and new road corridors to support long-term residential growth.

During Stage 1, Lackon collaborated with Council's planning and engineering teams to develop a comprehensive infrastructure design framework, including concept planning, phasing strategies, and stakeholder engagement mechanisms. This work culminated in a detailed project plan and early-stage design briefs that aligned the infrastructure layout with Council's residential zoning strategy, subdivision patterns, and future build-out scenarios.

Lackon's contribution extended beyond project coordination to include design oversight, ensuring that technical documentation supported both regulatory compliance and constructability. The infrastructure designs were developed with consideration for walkability, land activation, and safe, accessible transport networks.

Now in Stage 2 – Delivery, Lackon continues to provide support by ensuring infrastructure is delivered in accordance with the approved designs, while facilitating communication between Council, contractors, and key stakeholders.
